



3-man Events



DYE RiZE Beginners Division

PLAYER Fee per event: R450 (includes 1 box of paintballs)

Information:

- Players *don't* require a SARPL season membership to compete in this division
- Paintball equipment can be made available for players to use during the tournament that *don't* have their own equipment yet.
 - Marker
 - Loader
 - Mask
 - Cylinder
- One box paint supplied by the SARPL included in the price, but additional sponsored paintball brands are allowed at the event. Paintballs allowed from your preferred supplier or from the field on the day.
- No players with previous tournament (speedball) experience or players competing in a higher division allowed as a player on the team). Players can only compete in the Beginners Division for maximum one season, minimum two events.
- A player can't continue to participate in this division if they compete in another division in the SARPL.
- Players can register individually if they don't have a team and we will assist them to find a team.

Format:

- Race to 2
- Limited paint (Loader only)
- Game Time: 2min
- 10.5bps
- Team will play a minimum of 8 points
- Minimum 5 teams required to run this division

Roster:

- Max 5 players (only players with no current ranking at the beginning of the season and no previous speedball tournament experience)
- Max 2 staff/pit crew

Event Prizes (incl Super Cup):

Team Certificate + Medals (Top 3)



Division 5

Division 5 is for new players in competitive paintball, with their own equipment and/or players on the team with some tournament experience but not ranked higher than Division 5. The team can have 1 Division 4 player to assist.

Team Entry Fee: R800 (Early Bird Special: R600)

Format:

- Mercy 2
- Limited paint (Loader + 1 pod)
- Game Time: 4min
- 10.5bps

Roster:

- Max 5 players (any player ranked D5 or below and maximum 1 player ranked D4)
- Max 4 staff/pit crew
- Max 7 people on the roster

Division 4

Open Division is for more experienced, competitive paintball players with any rank in South Africa.

Team Entry Fee: R800 (Early Bird Special: R600)

Format:

- Mercy 2
- Limited paint (Loader + 1 pod)
- Game Time: 4min
- 10.5bps

Roster:

- Max 5 players (any player ranked D4 or below and maximum 1 player ranked D3/D2)
- Max 4 staff/pit crew
- Max 7 people on the roster

Event Prizes*:

Floating Provincial Season Trophy, Team Certificate + Medals

10+ Teams competing

1st Place: Free Entry to the next 3-man event (worth up to R800)

2nd / 3rd Place: Half Entry to the next 3-man event (worth up to R400)



Paintball Super Cup 2020 (3-man)

Team Entry Fee: R1600 (Early Bird: R1200)

Super Cup Trophy + Medals (1st – 3rd place)

Super Cup Prizes

1st Place: R1600 (cash or can be used towards next season entry)

2nd Place: R800 (cash or can be used towards next season entry)

3rd Place: R800 (cash or can be used towards next season entry)

Provincial Winner **

Season Provincial Trophy + Provincial Player Certificates (1st – 3rd place)

Average 10+ teams for the season in their respective division/province:

- 1st Place: Cash or Entry towards the upcoming season worth up to R2400.

National Winner ***

National Trophy + National Player Medals (1st – 3rd place) – minimum 10+ teams average

- 1st Place: Entry towards Paintball Super Cup 2021 worth up to R1600.

Note: National team scores are adjusted according to the number of teams competing at each event in their respective province.

Important

	Players competing in Division 5 or 4 must have a valid season membership (R720) or alternatively pay the incidental fee per event (R250)
	Only SARPL sponsored paintballs are allowed to be used at events
*	Divisions with 5-9 teams at an event will receive Half Entry for 1 st / 2 nd place. No Prizes for any division with less than 5 teams competing at an event.
**	Must compete in all 4 events in their respective province Average 5-9 teams for the season in their respective division/province: Entry towards the upcoming season for the team worth up to R1200
***	Must compete in <i>four</i> 3-man events as well as Paintball Super Cup 3-man Highest <i>four</i> 3-man events for the team calculated nationally as well as their Paintball Super Cup score will be used to determine the national winner. With 5-9 teams on average competing nationally: Entry Towards Paintball Super Cup 2021 worth up to R800.
	3 players from a team must remain the same from event to event for a team to keep their name competing in and to apply any team prizes. This includes moving into a new season.
